Clinic staff treat adults and children over one year for a wide range of conditions, including minor cuts and burns, infections and stings, suspected sprains and small bone breaks (from shoulder to fingers and knees to toes). Open 8am to 9pm every day. No appointment necessary. For enquiries, phone 0131 537 1330/1331.
- **Remember your community pharmacist:** For expert health information and advice, ask at your local pharmacy, where highly trained staff are providing even more services to protect your health and treat minor ailments.
- NHS 24 and NHS Lothian out-of-hours services: If you need urgent medical advice 'out of hours' (at weekends, nights, or on public holidays) that cannot wait until your GP practice opens, phone NHS 24 on 08454 24 24 24. If you need to be seen 'out-of-hours', an appointment will be made for you at the most convenient Out of Hours Centre.
